




The Market Entry Programme for SMEs in the context of foreign trade and investment promotion






What is lightweighting?

Material reduction: lower quantities of raw materials required in design and manufacturing

Lower weight and density = less energy required for use







Make the economic significance and ecological effects of lightweighting measurable.




Make the **benefits** of lightweighting **visible to consumers** and **promote professional networking** in lightweighting.
